Welcome to the 2019-2020 Religious Education year! This is a big year for you and your second grader, and we are excited to walk this journey with you. I would like to take this opportunity to share some important dates with you and encourage you to engage with your child's upcoming religious education.

You student will receive three books this year for religious education. There will be a textbook, a small First Reconciliation workbook, and a small First Eucharist workbook. Please make sure you review the small workbooks at least weekly with your child. It is important that your student receives reinforcement from home, as well as in class.

If you are looking for an additional instructional recourse, I strongly suggest the Dynamic Catholic Program Blessed. It is free and can be found at <https://dynamiccatholic.com/blessed>. Blessed has a short video series for both First Reconciliation and First Eucharist. These are great options for when your child wants to watch a show or needs entertainment while you are waiting at appointments or practices. The theology is sound and engaging!
