We value the health and safety of St. Mary Parish Pinckney employees and guests. Amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, St. Mary Parish Pinckney has implemented preventive measures in line with recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

Our focus is to ensure we meet the needs of those whom we serve while doing our part to keep our employees and our communities safe. For the latest updates, we recommend the guidance provided at the CDC website (cdc.gov/coronavirus).

Our worship spaces and Eucharistic Chapel will continue to be cleaned with disinfectant cleaning supplies regularly. Our Eucharistic Chapel is currently open for all of our spiritual fulfillment. We are continuing to follow the 10 people limit per space rule, for our Funeral Masses. We're offering live-streaming of our Masses and drive through Confessions.

Currently, we are taking recommended precautions while continuing minimal operations. While some of our employees can telework at least most of the time, we have instructed that any employees who work onsite follow below:

- Maintain a safe distance from one another (at least six feet).
- Wash their hands frequently (at least 20 seconds).
- Practice safe hygiene: cdc.gov/healthywater/hygiene/etiquette/coughing_sneezing
- Have hand sanitizer with at least 62% alcohol readily available.
- Cover their mouth and nose with a tissue and dispose of the tissue and wash hands. When a tissue is not available, use the crook of the elbow to cover the cough or sneeze.
- Stay home if they are not feeling well or have symptoms such as a fever (100.4° or more) or a cough or trouble breathing.
- Self-quarantine or seek medical treatment when necessary.

We are committed to continuing to serve our parishioners during this time.
