## **Google Slides Summer Reading**

For this Summer Reading Project, you will select a novel to read at home. You will then complete this project using Google Slides. You will submit your project during the first week of school on Google Classroom: Literature. You will be presenting this to the class as well.

Your slideshow must include at least 8 slides. Extra slides are allowed if they are needed to fit all of your information- remember that you don't want your slides to be cluttered. Each slide must include at least one picture. All pictures must be <u>relevant</u> to the story; do not fill your slideshow with random pictures! Details for what must be included on each slide can be found below:

- Slide 1 Title Slide: On this slide you will list your name, the title of the book, the author, the genre, and the year the book was published.
- <u>Slide 2 Setting</u>: Include a vivid description of the setting (BOTH time and place) through the use of sensory details. Explain why it is important and adds meaning to the story.
- <u>Slide 3-4 Characters</u>: Include a vivid description of 2 main characters with at least 3 physical characteristics and 3 personality traits for each. Provide a specific example from the story as proof of each personality trait.
- <u>Slide 5 Conflict</u>: Include a vivid description of the *main* conflict in the story. Also, explain how the conflict is resolved (or not resolved) at the end of the story.
- <u>Slide 6 Summary of Plot</u>: Include a vivid description of the plot. A good summary is a paragraph which includes only the main ideas and important details. It should be well organized and should cover the entire story, start to finish.
- <u>Slide 7– Theme</u>: Include a one sentence theme for the book. List 3 pieces of textual evidence to support the theme. Your evidence should be *direct quotes* from the novel. Be sure to include your own commentary to explain how each quote from the story supports the theme.
- <u>Slide 8 Recommendation</u>: Include a recommendation that explains why the book is worth reading or not worth reading. This is your opinion! Provide specific reasons for your opinion.

- You will be graded on grammar, spelling, and neatness.
- Feel free to add transitions and animations to enhance your slides!
